We are delighted to share the outcomes of our GCSE and Level 2 vocational courses. This cohort has experienced significant disruption to their studies and these results are a testament to their hard work, resilience, and sheer determination to succeed. Whilst we are of course proud of the achievements of all our students, there are a number who have excelled and achieved some truly exceptional results.

**Sydney** achieved five Grade 9s, three Grade 8s, and one Grade 7. Delighted with her results, Sydney said "I'm just so happy, these are amazing." Sydney will be studying for A levels in Art, History, Psychology, and English Literature.
